## **Description of the Event:**

The **HealthXcel Club** successfully hosted an engaging event, **OUTBREAK**, on November 21<sup>st</sup>, 2024. The event featured three thrilling rounds designed to test participants' problem-solving, creativity, and teamwork skills. With 72 enthusiastic participants, *Outbreak* was a lively competition that left an indelible mark on all who attended.

The opening round, *Encode-Decode*, challenged participants to crack a series of intricate codes. Each team was given specific patterns and logic-based puzzles that required quick thinking and strategic collaboration. Out of the 72 participants, only 10 teams advanced to the next round based on their ability to decode the given codes effectively.

The second round brought out the participants' creativity and entrepreneurial spirit. Teams were presented with various prompts and were tasked with pitching innovative solutions to the given problems. The format, inspired by *SHARK TANK*, pushed participants to think on their feet, articulate their ideas persuasively, and defend their proposals under scrutiny. Ultimately, 15 individuals progressed to the final round based on the quality and feasibility of their pitches.

The grand finale was an adrenaline-pumping treasure hunt themed around the *Outbreak* of a hypothetical infection. The participants were tasked with identifying an "infected" person hidden within the campus. Clues were strategically placed across various locations, leading the participants through different stages of the hunt. Elimination was incorporated at each stage, intensifying the competition. The round tested not only physical endurance but also problem-solving and analytical skills.

After a day of intense competition, the top three participants emerged victorious, showcasing exceptional skill and determination. They were honored with prizes that applauded their efforts and celebrated the spirit of learning and collaboration.

OUTBREAK proved to be a resounding success, combining fun and education seamlessly. It provided participants with an opportunity to explore real-world scenarios and develop critical thinking, creativity, and teamwork. The overwhelming participation and positive feedback have set a high benchmark, inspiring the club to organize more such events in the future.
