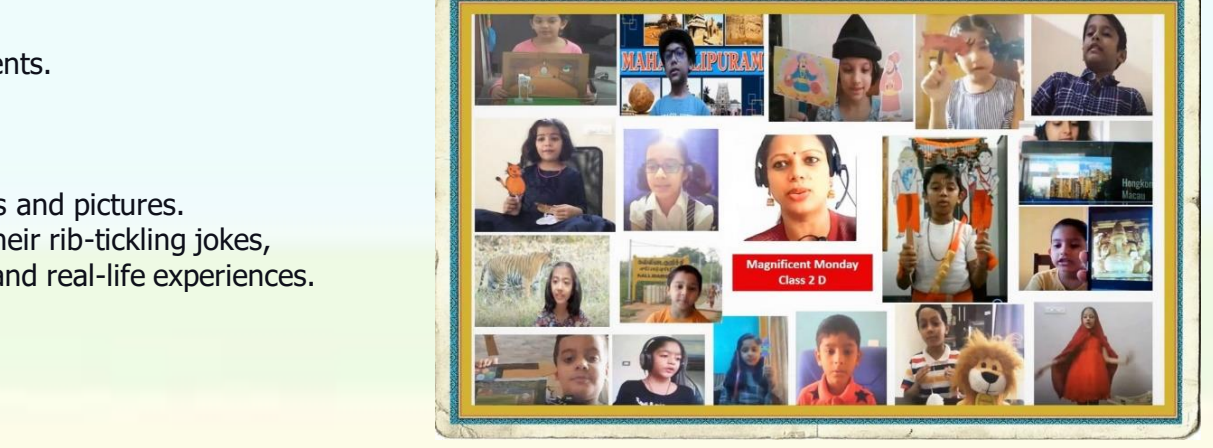

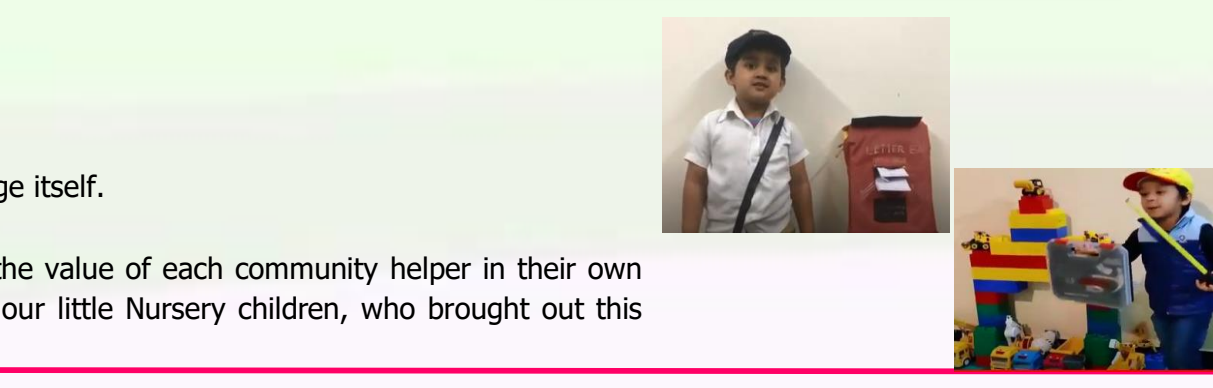

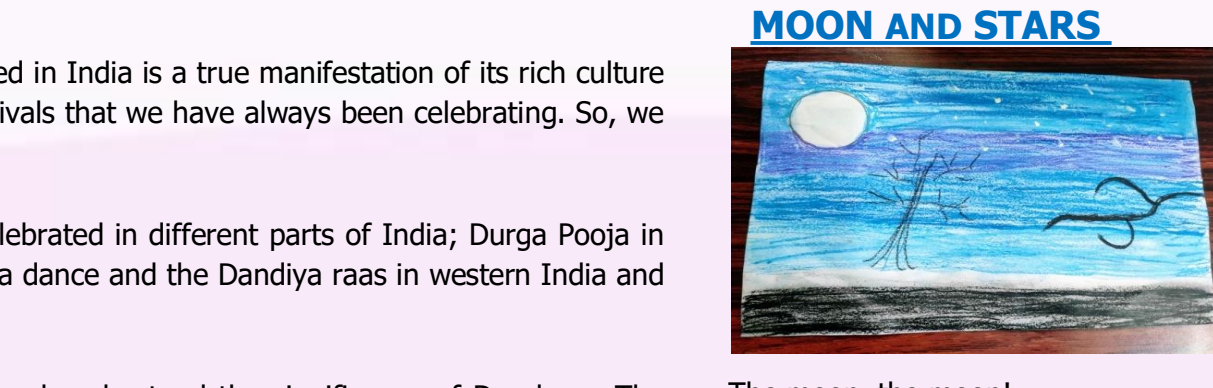


## VIRTUAL CELEBRATION OF DUSSEHRA CELEBRATION

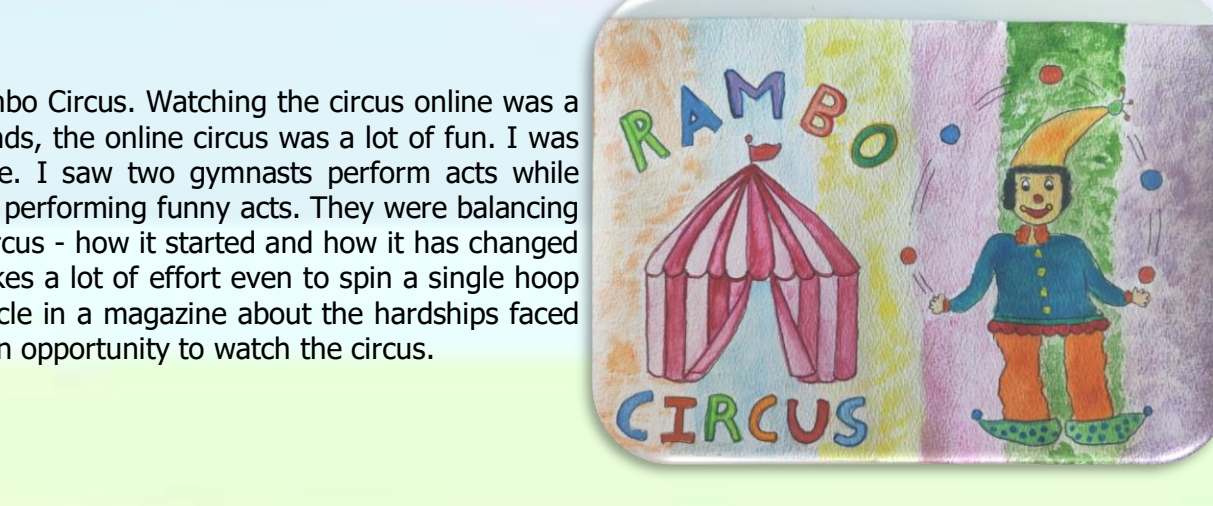

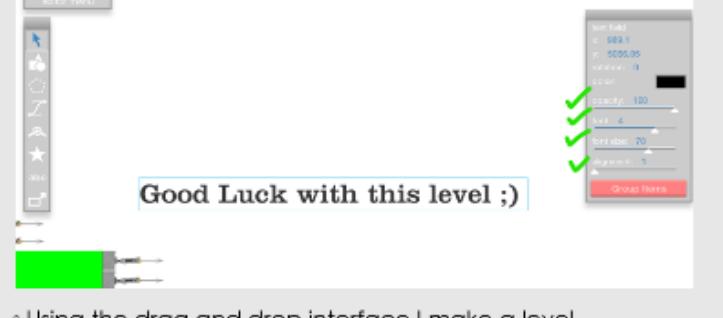
