#### A Taste Of Italy (With A Twist)

Just like bread and rice, pasta is a staple food. It comes in all sizes and shapes, making it highly exceptionally multifaceted. versatile and The thing about pasta is that it can be remarkably fancy and aesthetic. Here are two exciting pasta recipes for all.

### **Evening snacks**

#### Crispy pasta Ingredients:

- > water
- ➤ 1 tsp salt ➤ 2 tsp oil
- 2 cup macaroni pasta
- ▶ ¼ cup maida ▶ ½ cup cornflour
- > oil (for frying)
- **Tandoori flavour ingredients:**

#### ➤ 1 tsp chilli powder

- ▶ ½ tsp cumin powder
- ➤ ½ tsp coriander powder

#### ➤ 1 tsp chaat masala

- ▶ ¼ tsp salt

#### ▶ ½ tsp garam masala 1 tsp kasuri methi (crushed)

- **Chaat flavour Ingredients:**

- ¼ tsp pepper powder

### First, in a large vessel, take enough water.

**Steps for preparation of Crispy Pasta:** 

Add 1 tsp salt, 2 tsp oil and get to boil.

Once the water boils, add 2 cups of macaroni pasta, you can use any shape of your choice.

Boil for 7 minutes, or check package instructions to know the cooking time. Once the pasta is medium cooked, drain off the water.

Rinse with cold water to prevent overcooking the pasta.

Transfer the boiled pasta to a large bowl, and add ¼ cup maida and ¼ cup cornflour and mix

well. Add more cornflour if required and coat the pasta with flour.

Deep fry in hot oil, keeping the flame on low to medium.

Keep stirring in between and fry until the pasta turns golden and crispy, take at least 15 minutes

to get crispy macaroni (low flame). Drain off over kitchen towel/tissue paper to get rid of excess oil.

Take fried pasta in a large bowl. add 1 tsp chilli powder, ½ tsp cumin powder, ½ tsp coriander

**Crispy Pasta with Tandoori flavour:** 

powder, ½ tsp garam masala, 1 tsp kasuri methi and ¼ tsp salt.

Mix well making sure all the spices are well coated. Finally, enjoy tandoori flavoured pasta with evening tea.

#### **Crispy Pasta with Chaat flavour:**

Take fried pasta in a large bowl. add 1 tsp chaat masala, ¼ tsp pepper powder and ¼ tsp salt. Mix well making sure all the spices are well coated. Finally, enjoy chaat-flavoured pasta with evening tea.


Ground units were immediately called on to assist the plane and passengers, and it landed without trouble. The aeroplane landed upon

Philadelphia 76ers, after struggling for the better part of the early 2010s, with a subpar roster with little to no trade assets, had no option but to tank, and "Trust the Process", hoping that eventually the draft lottery would land them young talent in the draft. This dream became a reality, as they landed Markelle Fultz, one of the most hyped up prospects at the time, Joel Embiid, a player who has proved to be an MVP caliber center, and Ben Simmons, who won the Rookie of the Year in the 2017-2018, after missing the 2016-2017 season due to a foot injury.

Flash forward to the 2021 season, Joel Embiid still continues to produce at a monumental rate, averaging brunt 28.5 points, 10.6 rebounds, 2.8 product assists and an impressive 37% from behind the arc on 3 attempts a game, as well as being a defensive anchor for the team. A rift however, has arisen in the team, as Ben Simmons hasn't produced nearly well considering enough, expectations on him.

Only time can tell us what will happen, so make sure to stay tuned.
